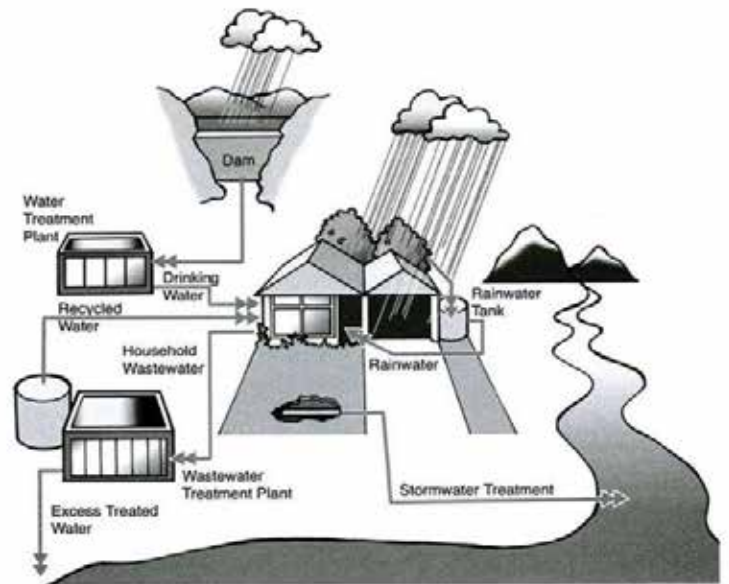

Task 1: The diagram below shows how rainwater is reused. Summarize the information by selecting and reporting the main features and make comparisons where relevant.

The illustration provides information about several different methods of utilizing rainwater for residential usage.

Overall, it can be clearly seen that the process consists of multiple steps and loops, starting with water collection and ending with treated wastewater flowing into rivers.

➤ Reservoir = lake

The cycle commences when rainwater is gathered in either an artificial reservoir or open water tanks in each residence. The lake water is then pumped into a water purification plant to be cleansed and made into drinking water while the amount stored in household storages can be used directly for domestic usage.

➤ Household = residence

➤ Purification = treatment = cleanse

The procedure continues when household wastewater is gathered in a treatment factory, where it is recycled and filtered to return to its cleansed state before being pumped back into the water supply system to be used by families. In the following step, having been treated, the excess clean water then flows into rivers together with treated stormwater accumulated through storm drains around the area.
